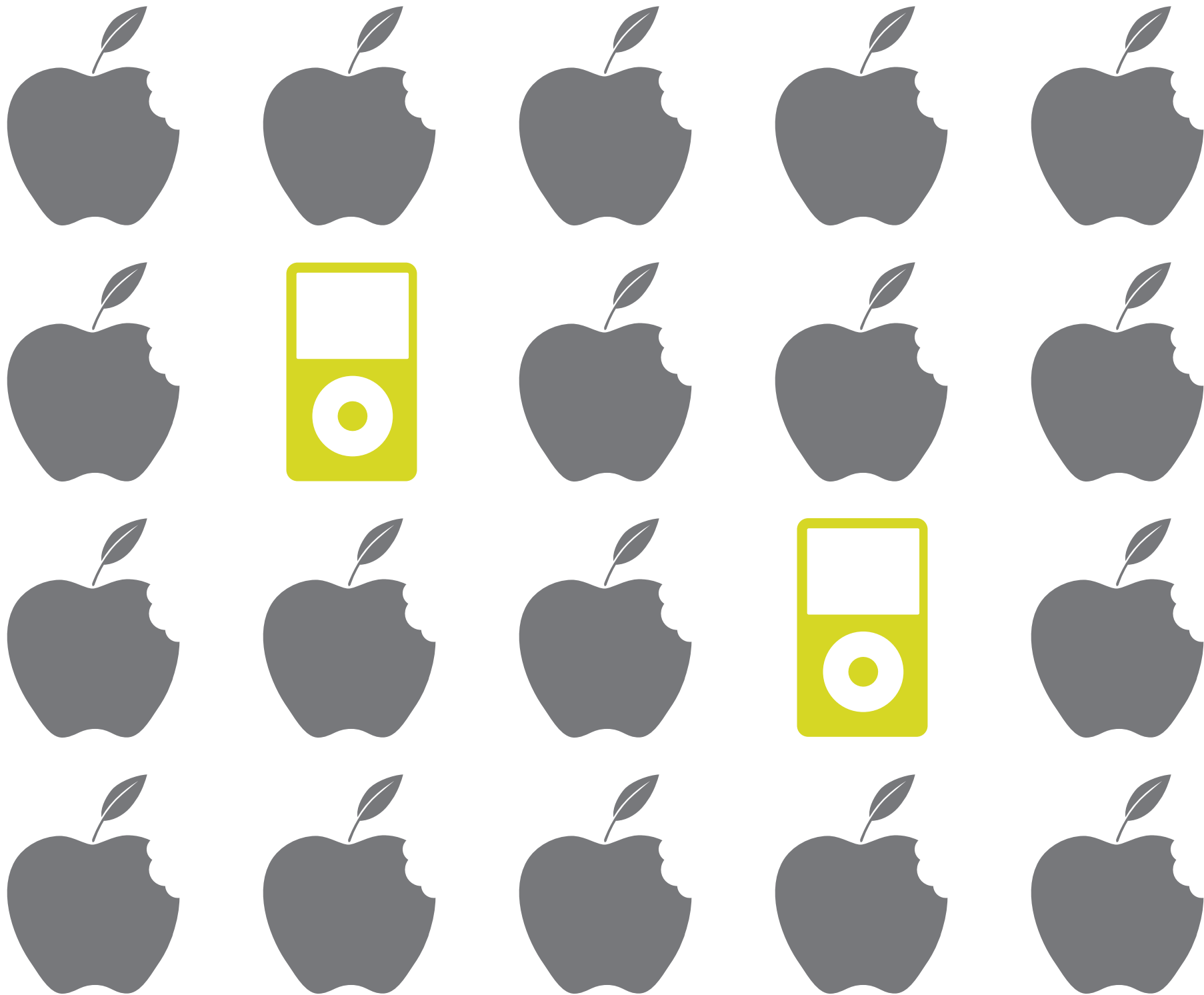


McIntosh, Red Delicious, Cortland, iPod, Empire...
